In a landmark judgement, the Supreme Court categorically has laid down that "hijras" or transgender constitute "third gender" neither male nor female having their own valid entitlement for all human rights like all other human beings relieving them from their dilemma of what to mention in the gender column of any application i.e. whether male or female as they are neither male nor female.

The Supreme Court has observed that the third gender cannot be discriminated against with respect to equal opportunities in education, employment and other spheres that their claim must be considered at par with male and female.

Software	Manuscript must be submitted in Microsoft Word 2007 in the above format ONLY.
Title	Written in bold, size 14 and centered margin.
Author/s	Name, address, e-mail and contact number of all authors, size 12, in Times New Roman font format.
Abstract	Between 300-350 words, Times New Roman, size 12.
Keywords	Should not contain more than FIVE keywords.
Title/ Sub Title	Written in bold, size 12 and left margin.
Tables/ Figures	Title of the tables/figure should be written on the top of the tables/figure. Times New Roman, font 12, Bold and centered margin.
Footnoting	Footnoting should be done strictly according to Bluebook 19th Edition , Times New Roman, Size 10, Line-Spacing 1.
Word Limit	Articles should be generally of 4000-4500 words (excluding references and footnotes).
