The current trends emphasize cooperation and coordination, rather than demarcation of powers, between different governments. The Centre, for its part, feels displeased at the attitude of States over various issues. The Centre also resents the States' for claiming the credit of successful implementation of Centrally-sponsored projects. It is felt that the real source of many of our problems is the tendency of centralization of powers and misuse of authority. The Seminar aims at Centre-State relationship in India in the light of constitutional provisions. In the current scenario, with the confrontation among the different parties ruling at the Centre and in the States this issue becomes more relevant and deserve more focus and greater contemplation.
