- 1 A. Beleriand is one of the oldest civilisations on the planet. It has a cultural history aging back to
- 2 3000 years while its mythological stories go way beyond known timeline. The Old Gods is the
- most predominant faith in Beleriand which has been practiced by over 70 per cent of the
- 4 population. One of the most prominent sites for the worshipers of the Old Gods is
- 5 Godswood. Beleriand was divided into smaller kingdoms with autonomous administration
- but for the foreign entities, the entire area was referred to as Beleriand. One such kingdom
- 7 was Hogsmede.
- 8 **B.** Beleriand has been a culturally mixed society. In the past, several travellers and traders have
- 9 come to Beleriand bringing their faith along with them. All the faiths found their space and
- 10 followers in Beleriand. One such faith is the Lord of Lights. Lord of Lights arrived in
- Beleriand in late 600 BCE and had a modest and peaceful presence; however, it became a
- 12 predominant faith in Hogsmede.
- 13 C. Along with a rich and mixed cultural history, the modern history of Beleriand was chequered
- with blood. Being one of the most affluent economies of its time and due to its geological
- location, Beleriand was under constant attacks by several kingdoms and tribes among which
- most notable was the Kingdom of Valeria which practices the faith of Lord of Lights. In one
- such raid, the ancient structure standing at Godswood was destroyed by Stringer Bell who
- built another structure over it for the devotees of Lord of Light.
- 19 **D.** Later, around 1600, Beleriand came under the rule of Asgard. However, despite being under
- 20 the rule of Asgard, the kings of several Kingdoms in Beleriand still enjoyed their position
 - notionally while the administrative power remained solely in the hands of Asgard. Several
- 22 institutional reforms and practices were brought into effect during this time, however, the
- primary motive of all such reforms were to ensure maximum tax collection by Asgard. One
- such rule was regarding preparation of revenue records showing ownership of people over
- property for the purposes of collecting taxes. In this record one such name was of Athelstan,
- 26 who was a priest of Lord of Lights. Athelstan along with his family had relocated to
- Hogsmeade. Later, Godswood was transferred to the King of Hogsmeade by the descendants
- 28 of Athelstan.

- 29 E. In 1947, Beleriand, its kingdoms including Hogsmeade were declared Independent by Asgard.
- The kingdoms falling in the administrative territory of Asgardian rule of Beleriand, including
- 31 Hogsmeade was given the option of either staying independent or to join in Union with
- 32 Beleriand. While all the kingdoms joined the Union with Beleriand, some demanded certain

- privileges or special provisions. Hogsmeade did not ask for any such privilege. During this
- 34 time, Kingdom of Valeria, on the pretext of Hogsmeade to be a kingdom of followers of
- 35 Lords of Lights asked the ruler to join Kingdom of Valeria.
- 36 F. As a result, Hogsmeade was in constant pressure from both Kingdom of Valeria and
- 37 Beleriand for joining them and it was during this time that it was attacked by Kingdom of
- 38 Valeria. In the light of this development, ruler of Hogsmeade joined the Union of Beleriand
- 39 with certain special provisions granted for the territory of Hogsmeade. However, the battle
- 40 between Beleriand and Kingdom of Valeria only reached ceasefire after the intervention of
- 41 the international community wherein it was declared by Beleriand and Kingdom of Valeria
- 42 that the decision of the future of Hogsmeade will be taken by its people in a plebiscite after
- 43 Kingdom of Valeria removes its forces. However, Kingdom of Valeria refused to remove its
- forces and hence no plebiscite took place.
- 45 G. Thereafter, the relationship between the people staying in Hogsmeade and Beleriand
- 46 remained cordial for some time till insurgent movements started taking place in Hogsmeade
- and a demand for succession started gathering pace.
- 48 H. On the other side, the followers of Old Gods were unhappy with the structure of Lord of
- 49 Lights being standing at Godswood and resentment were growing. As a result, a crowd of
- Old Gods followers entered the premises and demolished the structure standing. This
- 51 brought turmoil in the country as clashes between the followers of the two religious started
- 52 taking place all over the country. Further, a civil suit was filed by Sartaj Singh, a follower of
- 53 Old Gods, claiming title over the property in the name of Old Gods. This was contested by
- Guddu Pandit, ruler of Hogsmeade, who claimed it to be his property.
- 55 I. The Court of Original Jurisdiction referred the matter to the High Court which in a deferred
- 56 judgment, ordered division of Godswood. Unhappy with the decision, the parties approached
- 57 the Apex Court of Beleriand where after preliminary hearing; the Court directed the parties to
- mediate among themselves and appointed a two member panel to mediate for the same.

¹ Special Provisions for the Accession of Hogsmeade

a. No law passed by Beleriand will be enforceable in Hogsmeade without the assent of the legislative assembly of Hogsmeade.

b. No person of Beleriand will be allowed to buy property in Hogmeade.
