Online Elocution Competition

- **Rules for Online Elocution competition:**

- Only **25 participants** will be allowed to participate on First come, First serve basis.
- This is a Two-Day event.
- There will be two rounds i.e. **Knock-out and Final**
- On Day 1, in knock-out round, the participant is at liberty to choose topic **according to the theme mentioned above.**
- 3 mins + 2 mins (warning time) = 5 mins (total time allotted) will be given to participants to speak on the chosen topic.
- After the first round, the results will be announced and **only 10 participants will be selected for final round** who shall be notified by the organisers.
- On Day 2 i.e. Final round, the **theme will be disclosed to the participant 1 hour prior to the Event** and the topic, related to the theme, will be given to the participants by the organising team **on time.**
- 5 mins time will be given to the participants to prepare their speech.
- 2 mins + 1 min (warning time) = 3 mins (total time allotted) will be given for speech.
- Language for speech can be **English or Hindi.** Only one of the languages shall be used by the participant for speech.

- k. The participant shall maintain the general etiquettes of presentation.
- l. The participant shall strictly follow the time frame.
- m. The participant shall not read any part of the script from paper or employ any foul method to read the script.
- n. If the participant fails to adhere with the rules, he/she shall be disqualified from the competition with immediate effect.

- **Judgement Criteria for Elocution Competition:**

- a. Total 100 points
- b. Title and Introduction: 10 points
- c. Structure, Organisation and balance: 10 points
- d. Content: 20 points
- e. Language: 15 points
- f. Voice Navigation and Body Language: 25 marks
- g. Conclusion: 10 points
- h. Overall effectiveness: 10 points

Article Writing Competition

- **Rules for Article Writing:**

- a. The language of writing shall be **English**.
- b. Co-authorship of the article – not allowed**
- c. The **cover page** shall have Title of Article, Name of the Author, Name of the Course and semester, Institution/ Organisation and Contact details
- d. The cover page should be separate from the main article.
- e. The article submitted, should be an **original and unpublished work**. If found violative of the terms, the participant shall be eligible to be disqualified.

NOTE: Even an excerpt which has been previously published as a small part of a published work shall be considered as previous work. No previously published works allowed. On violation of this rule, participant shall be disqualified with immediate effect.

- f. The minimum word limit shall be 500 words whereas the maximum word limit shall be 1200 words.**
- g. The participant should strictly follow **Standard Indian Legal Citation** as a mode of citation. The draft should compulsorily have footnotes. Endnotes shall not accept. If a participant is found using endnotes, he/she shall be eligible for disqualification.
- h. The format to be used is as follows:
 - i. Font Name: Times New Roman,

- ii. Color: Black
- iii. Headings: Bold, Font size: 16
- iv. Sub-headings: Font size: 14
- v. Body: Normal, Font size: 12
- vi. Footnotes: Normal, Font size: 10

The above stated rules are to be strictly followed. Violation shall lead to immediate disqualification.

- i. To ensure the originality of the work submitted, a **plagiarism check** shall be done. Any work that **exceeds the limit of 12%** shall be disqualified immediately.

- **Submission Guidelines:**

- a. Each participant has to submit the article by **25th July, 2020 till 11:59 pm**. No delay, whatsoever, shall be entertained subsequently. The article shall be submitted via email on **Email id: thelawclubgroup@gmail.com** .
- b. The email shall consist of two attachments – Article and Cover page
- c. Both the documents shall be mailed in one single email.
- d. **No other mode of submission shall be entrained.**

- **Marking scheme of Article Writing Competition**

- a. Total 100 points
- b. Language and Grammar – 25 points
- c. Content – 25 points

- e. Structure and Flow – 25 points

- **Other rules:**

- a. The organisers will not be responsible for any loss caused due to loss of connectivity or any other technical issues from the participant.
- b. The organisers will not be responsible for any copyright infringement and/or damage caused to the intellectual property of any person
- c. The registration fee is non-refundable.
- d. In the case of tie or conflict, the decision of the organisers will be final
- e. Rights of admission rests with the organisers.
