THEME

This year's broad theme is, "New Work and New Workers: Rethinking the Labour Law Framework."

The following are the sub-themes:

- 1. Change in work, women at work and future of labour law: Gender Dimensions
- 2. Towards a new terminology for 'political economy of labour' in Indian context: Inquiry into intersectional language in Labour Law.
- 3. Legal understanding of trade unionism: Gaps in practice of different stakeholders
- 4. Debate on flexible labour: Justiciable approach in Labour Law
- 5. Road to Social Justice: Labour Constitutionalism in India
- 6. Covid 19 and Labour: Labour Law approach

*The above list of sub-themes is merely suggestive and not exhaustive. Participants are free to select any topic falling under the broad theme.







ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The competition is open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students enrolled in any discipline in a recognized University/ College/ Institute in India.
- 2. Only one submission per author shall be entertained.
- 3. No Co-authorship allowed.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

- 1. The articles must be submitted in English only.
- 2. The articles should be the original work of the authors. Any kind of plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- 3. The articles published elsewhere or selected/submitted for publication elsewhere shall be disqualified.
- 4. The author is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the facts, opinions or views in the submission.
- 5. Submissions should not contain content that is offensive, abusive, derogatory or potentially defamatory.
- 6. The name of the author should not be mentioned anywhere in the article, including the file properties/metadata.
- 7. The word limit for the article is 2000–2500 words, not including footnotes.
- 8. The articles should be typed in: Times New Roman, Font Size 12 and Line Spacing 1.5.
- 9. The footnotes must be typed in: Times New Roman, Font Size 10 and Line Spacing 1.
- 10. The footnotes can follow either Bluebook 20th edition or OSCOLA 4th edition.
- 11. The margins should be 1" or 2.54 cm on all sides.
- 12. All text should be justified.







- 13. Submissions shall be assessed as per the criteria and weightage of marks (total: 100 marks) as specified:
 - a. Understanding of the Theme and the Sub-themes (10)
 - b. Quality of Research (30)
 - c. Originality and Creativity (10)
 - d. Language, Grammar and Style (15)
 - e. Organization, Structure and Clarity of Expressions (20)
 - f. Quality and Viability of Suggestions or Recommendations made (15)
- 14. In case of any conflicts, IDIA Delhi Chapter shall be the final authority on the guidelines.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. The articles must be sent by email to idiadelhichaptersubmission@gmail.com
- 2. The article must be titled: Subject Name_College Name.
- 3. The essay must be attached only in MS Word (.doc or .docx) format.
- 4. The body of the e-mail must specify the name of the author.
- 5. The participants are required to send the following details in a **separate** word document attached to the e-mail:
 - a. Title of the Article
 - b. Sub-theme Chosen
 - c. Name of the author, College/Institute/University of author, programme enrolled, and year of study of author
 - d. E-mail address and contact number of the author.
