

OUTLINE OF THE EVENT



Teams of two must be formed from the contestants. There will be twentyfour teams overall, each with two individuals

The teams shall be provided with a problem, balanced in a manner which shall compel the teams to enter into a merger which will have a boon and bane.

There will be draw of lots; for or against the stance of supporting merger.

The objective is to find a way for both merged teams to create a working environment for both the companies involved in the merger and whether the merger will be beneficial or not.

At the end, the team should go through the features and characteristics of the amalgamation and point out how each company's values and guiding principles are mirrored in it. The group must also talk about the legal consideration.

The team with the best argument wins.

RULES OF THE EVENT



- A student may register for LE DILEMMA within the stipulated date and time, as mentioned in the schedule announced.

- EXPLAINING THE COMPANY'S LEGAL ASPECTS AND THE INTENDED OBJECTIVE BEHIND THE AMALGAMATION.
